

How to Author and Burn DVD Folders and DVDs

An Overview

What can you create?


1. A DVD VIDEO_TS folder on your hard drive.
2. Burn a DVD.
3. Create ISO file on your hard drive.

There are many methods to author and burn DVDs

1. You can author (and burn) a single file.
2. You can author (and burn) multiple files (through the DVD menu.)
3. You can burn a DVD from an existing VIDEO_TS folder or ISO file.

Getting started:

Load your file into VideoReDo and begin editing. After you have finished editing, you either create a DVD containing this single video or add the video for a DVD with multiple titles.

To create a single title DVD, you can click on the  button from the main window.

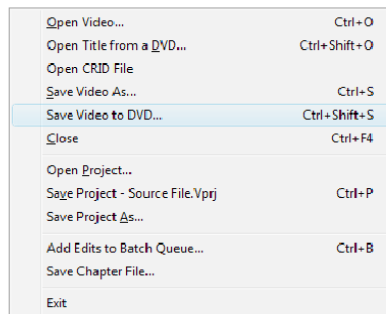
If you are adding this file to a multi-title DVD, click on the  button from the main window.

You can also create DVDs using the menus as explained below.

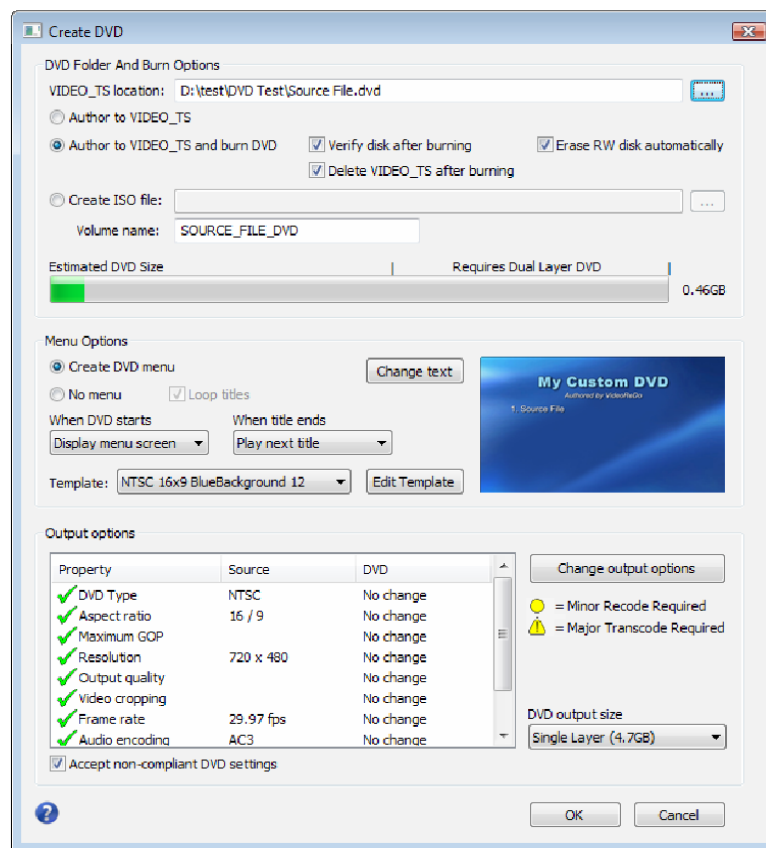
1. The File menu (for a single title DVD.)
2. The DVD menu (for a multiple title DVD.)
3. The DVD Title Edit List window (for a multiple title DVD.)
4. The DVD menu (to burn a DVD or create an ISO file.)

Where are the options for authoring and burning?

1. The File menu (for a single title DVD.)





Select "Save Video to DVD". This will display the Create DVD project screen.

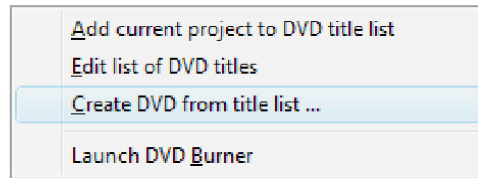


You can choose to:

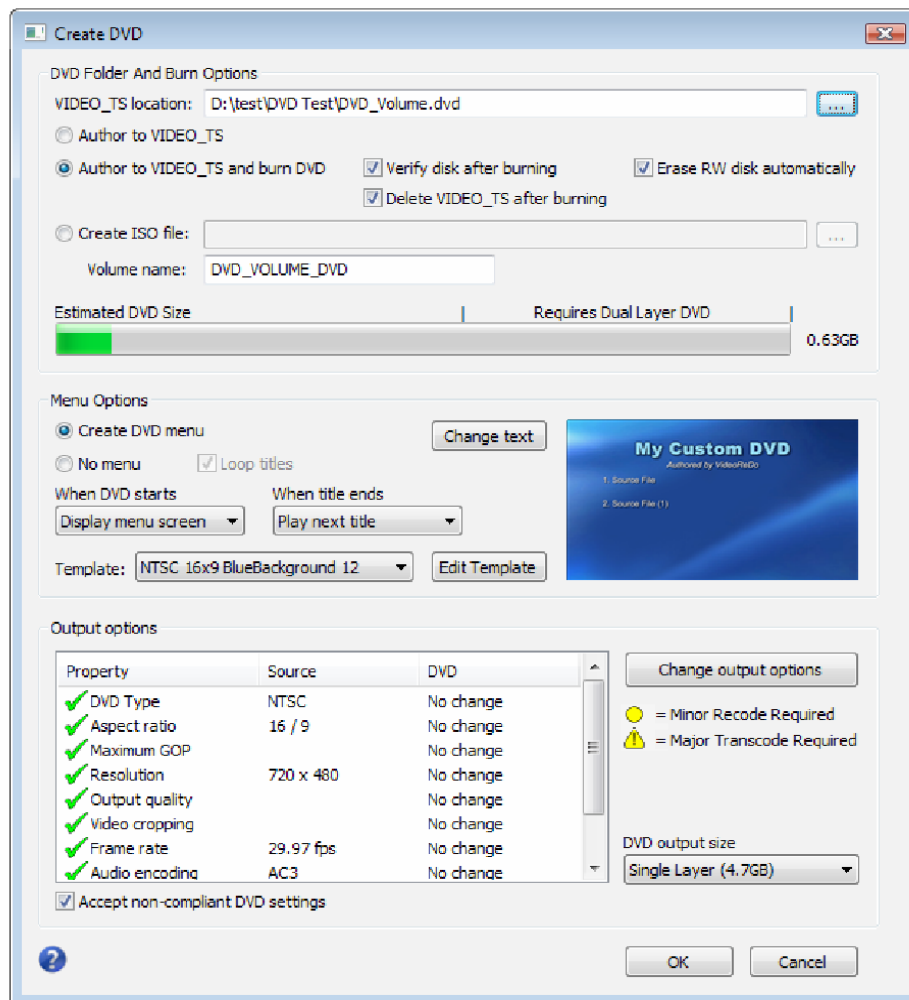
- A. Author a DVD folder

2. The DVD menu (for a multiple title DVD.)





Select “Create DVD from title list”. This will display the Create DVD project screen.

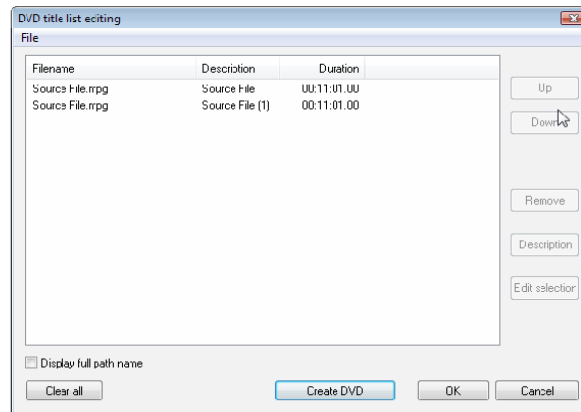


You can choose to:

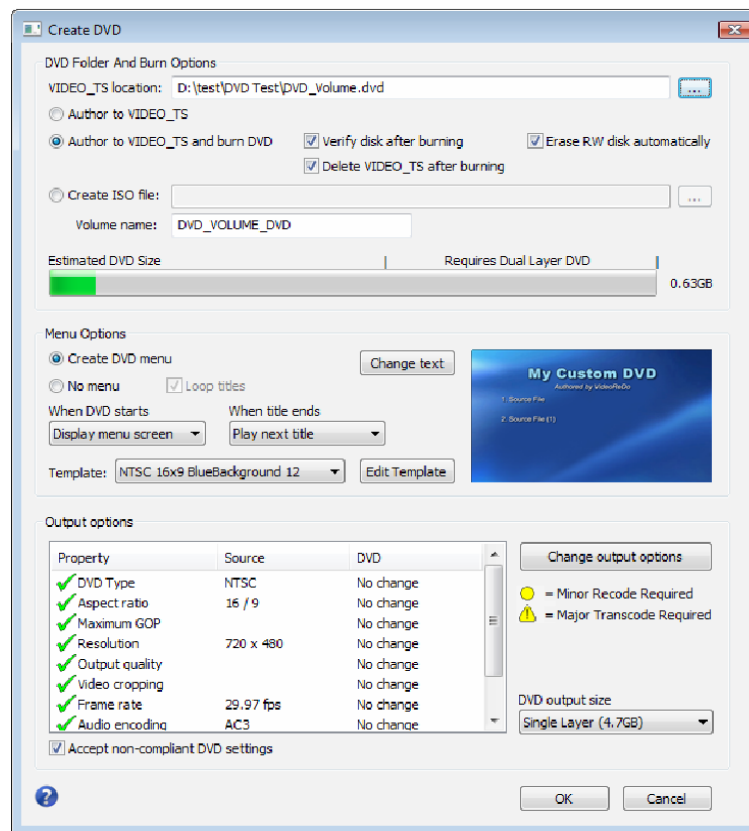
- A. Author a DVD folder

3. The DVD Title Edit List window (for a multiple title DVD.)





Click the “Create DVD” button. This will display the Create DVD project screen.

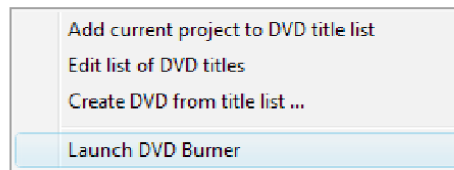


You can choose to:

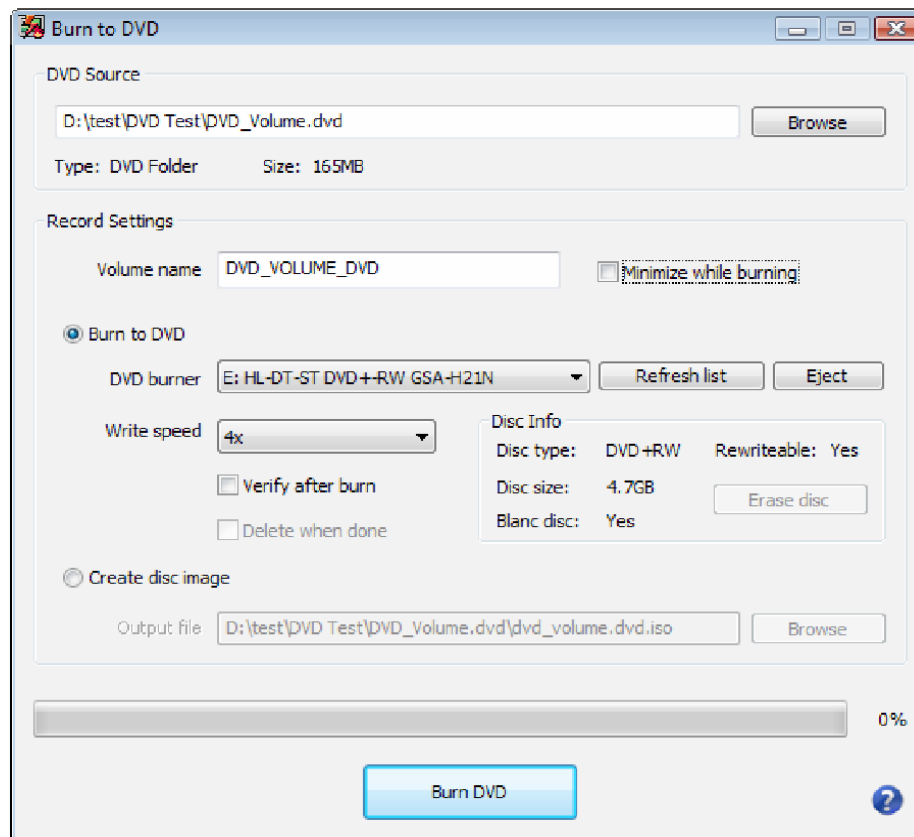
- A. Author a DVD folder

4. The DVD menu (to burn a DVD or create an ISO file.)



Select "Launch DVD Burner"



You can choose to import a:

- A. DVD folder
- B. ISO file

You can choose to output a:

- A. DVD (using your burner)
- B. ISO file (disk image)
